## START:

Coventry, War Memorial Park, by the Coat of Arms Bridge Road entrance on the south of the park. OS Grid Reference: SP 323 768 (Sheet 140) Post Code: CV3 6PY What3Words:///quit.wisdom.agreed

Check-in opens: 0745 hrs.  
Groups leave: 0800 - 0845 hrs.

## RAILWAY STATION:

Coventry: 1.5 miles north of the start.

## CAR PARKING:

The entrance to the main car park is opposite Beechwood Road and costs £5 all day. You may be able to park on local roads.


## THE EVENT:


**Check-in at the start:** In a gazebo in the park near the Coat of Arms Bridge Road entrance.

**Check-out at the finish:** At the Burnt Post, Kenpas Highway (CV3 6AW ///spaces.monks.socket). A tab for £5/head will be available at the bar.

**The route** uses OS Landranger maps 152: Northampton & Milton Keynes; 140: Leicester & Coventry; and 151: Stratford-upon-Avon.

**Each group** of ten riders will have its own leader. Route maps will not be necessary, although it is always sensible to carry a paper map when riding in unfamiliar areas. **It is important** to check-out at the end of the event so we can ensure that everyone has finished safely, and you can take advantage of the £5/head tab at the bar.

There will be an **assistance vehicle** available throughout the event to deal with any incidents that cannot be handled beside the road.

The route is a circular route using some of our favourite lanes in the area.
