Coventry, War Memorial Park, by the Coat of Arms Bridge Road entrance on the south side of the park.

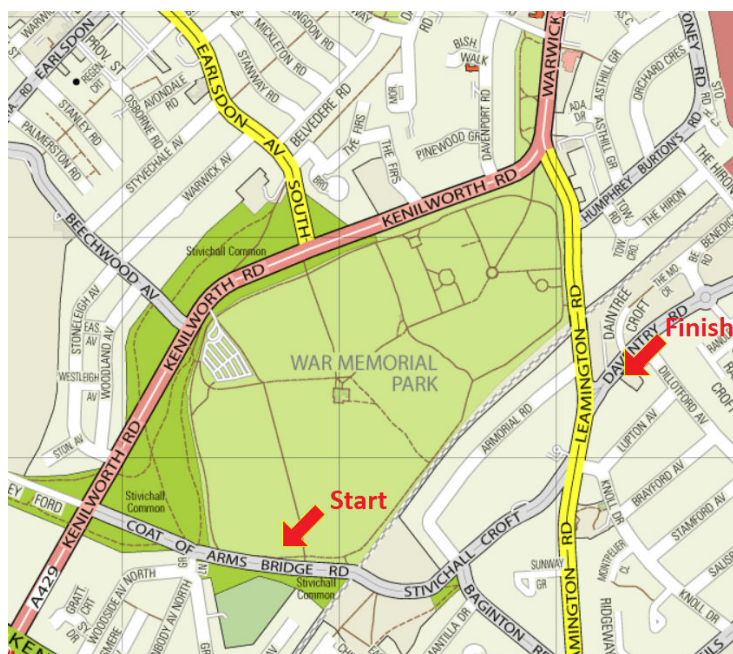
Groups leave: 0845 - 0930 hrs.

RAILWAY STATION:

Coventry: 1.5 miles north of the start.

CAR PARKING:

The entrance to the main car park is opposite Beechwood Road and costs £5 all day. You may be able to park on local roads.



THE EVENT:

Check-in at the start: In a gazebo in the park near the Coat of Arms Bridge Road entrance.

Check-out at the finish: At the Open Arms pub on Daventry Road close to the eastern edge of War Memorial Park (CV3 5DP [quit.wisdom.agreed](https://www.what3words.com/builds.hurt.loops)). A complementary drink / hot drink and a mini-pudding will be available.

The route uses OS 1:50,000 maps 140: Leicester & Coventry; 151: Stratford-upon-Avon; and 152: Northampton & Milton Keynes area.

Each group of ten riders will have its own leader. Route maps will not be necessary, although it is always sensible to carry a paper map when riding some distance from home. A small-scale route can be viewed on our website: <http://coventryctc.org.uk/100-km-centenary-challenge-ride> and a gpx file of the route can also be accessed.

It is important to formally check-out at the end of the event so we can ensure that everyone has finished safely, you can collect your souvenir lapel badge and have a cup of tea.

There will be an **assistance vehicle** available throughout the event to deal with any incidents that cannot be handled beside the road.

The route is a circular route using some of our favourite lanes around the Avon - Nene watershed on the Warwickshire - Northamptonshire border.

All catering is pre-paid with a **Morning Break** at The Harvester Inn, Long Itchington consisting of:
